The NSW Government is working with the NSW DNSPs (Ausgrid, Endeavour Energy, and Essential Energy) to develop a new portal that creates a single, simple, and streamlined process for solar businesses in NSW to install solar, batteries and other Consumer Energy Resource (CER) technologies.

The Portal supports the rapid growth of solar, batteries and renewable technologies by enabling the registration and testing of installed energy technology, the Emergency Backstop Mechanism and Flexible Export limits for solar customers.

We have been engaging with solar businesses and industry groups on the early development of the new, single installer portal, and we are keen to continue that approach. **We invite you to participate in a short workshop** (details below) to provide feedback and insights on how the portal design and functionality is shaping up, and the training and support you need to use the new portal with maximum ease.
